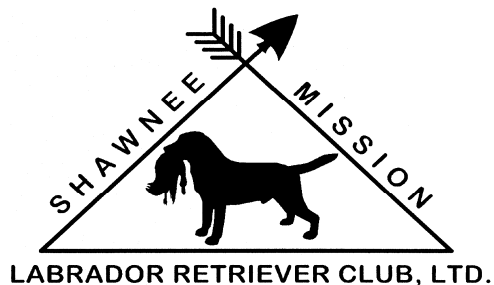

Credit cards will be accepted as payment for entries – See FAX ENTRY SERVICE information following Entry Fees. Overpayment of entry fees by \$10 or less per day will not be refunded.*

* For dogs & bitches who have earned any AKC Hunt Test Title or who have received a Judge's Award of Merit (Jam) or better in any AKC Field Test.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – MULTIPLE ENTRIES

Stud Dog. For stud dogs & two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. Get must be entered in a Regular class, Best of Breed or some other non-regular class. If the Stud Dog is entered in another class, there is no charge for entering the Stud Dog Class. The Stud Dog may be entered in Stud Dog class competition only at the regular entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are non considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or be excused under the Stud Dog rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog class is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Brood Bitch. Same class as Stud Dog Class, but substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Open to any dog, Champion or non-champion, who has reached the age of 7 years or more. Altered dogs and bitches may be entered. Veteran Sweepstakes entrants need not be entered in another Regular or Non-Regular class. Entry Fee is \$20.00. The same classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Open to any purebred Labrador Retriever, six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age, and entered in any of the Regular Classes at the Specialty Show at which these Sweepstakes are held. Champions of Record are not eligible. Entry Fee is \$20.00.

Best Puppy competition will be for winners of the puppy dog and puppy bitch classes only. Dogs over 12 months of age are not considered puppies. Best Bred by Exhibitor will be for the winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Dog and Bred by Exhibitor Bitch classes only. Only dogs/bitches not defeated are eligible for Best Puppy and Best Bred by Exhibitor Competition.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Entries close Wednesday, 6 PM, September 7, 2011, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Telephone entries are not acceptable. All entries are to be mailed with correct fees to the Show Secretary, Lois Roegge. Make checks payable to SMLRC, Ltd.

AKC Fees of \$3.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This fee is to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chap 11, Sec 2).

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with International Money Orders in U.S. Funds.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries. Facsimile machine entries will be accepted only by Entries On Time. Credit cards will be accepted as payment for entries. **See FAX ENTRY SERVICE information following Entry Fees.**

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a Cash Only basis.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

No RV Parking/Camping allowed on the Show Grounds.

The Show Site will be open at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, SEPTEMBER 24, 2011.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. **Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show – none will be mailed.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NOTICE – WAIVER OF RIGHTS. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the SMLRC Ltd, or its members; in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.

Agents may indicate their name on entry forms for inclusion in the catalog, provided they are 18 years old or older and neither own or co-own the dog. AGENTS WISHING TO RECEIVE A JUDGING SCHEDULE MUST INCLUDE MAILING INFORMATION if address is different from that of the owner.

SMLRC is not responsible for any belongings left at the show site.
